VINEYARD

- Varietals: Malbec
- Soils: clay and silt
- Size of the vineyard: 0.8 ha
- Young vines
- Planting density: 4 500 /ha
- Average Yield: 22 hl/ha

VINIFICATION AND AGEING

- without sulphur from harvest to bottling. Low temperature fermentation. Indigenous yeasts. Soft and fractioned pump overs. Short maceration.
- Aging in stainless steel vats
- Bottling at the château
- Production: 2 000 bottles

TASTING NOTES

Color: Brilliant, intense purple.

Nose: Very expressive nose with notes of cherry, strawberry and spices.

Palate: Powerful and generous attack. Well-balanced mid-palate with aromas of black cherry, blueberry and violet. The finish has a good length, suggesting a good ageing potential.
